Library	Core
Action	Terminate a running process (or set of process instances of the same executable).
Parameters	<p>Executable (string): The filename of the executable to kill.</p> <p>For Windows, this is the basename (e.g. "notepad.exe").</p> <p>For Linux it can be the basename (e.g. "firefox") or the full path (e.g. "/usr/lib64/firefox/firefox").</p>
Return values	<p>Killed (int): The number of processes successfully killed.</p> <p>Failed (int): The number of processes that could not be killed.</p>
Example	<pre>OperatingSystem.KillProcesses(Executable:"notepad.exe");</pre> <pre>OperatingSystem.KillProcesses(Executable:"/usr/lib64/firefox/firefox");</pre>
