Action	Gets the value of the given Nomad "variable".
Parameters	<p><code>VariableName</code> (string): Name of the variable to get.</p> <p>A variable can be any piece of info about Nomad such as a registry setting or even some computed value based on the current state of Nomad. This API is meant to be a flexible way of getting info out from Nomad which can be extended in future without breaking any COM interfaces. Currently the following three are the only supported variables:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <code>CacheAvailableBytes</code>: The disk space currently available to Nomad for its cache in bytes.2. <code>CacheUsedBytes</code>: The disk space currently used by Nomad.3. <code>SSDEnabled</code>: The value of registry setting "SSDEnabled".
Return values	<code>Value</code> (string): The value of the requested variable.
Example	<p>Get the current value of Nomad setting "SSDEnabled":</p> <pre>Nomad.GetVariable(VariableName: "SSDEnabled");</pre>
